

## CDL CERTIFICATION FOR WAIVER OF SKILLS TESTS

Waiver is **ONLY** valid for one year after discharge or for active duty, National Guard or reserve members who are currently licensed and are or were employed within the last year in a military position requiring operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a commercial motor vehicle (CMV)

- Being under the influence of alcohol or controlled substance
- Commission of a felony involving the use of a motor vehicle
- Use of a motor vehicle in a felony involving the manufacture, distribution, or dispensing of a controlled substance
- Refusing to take an alcohol test as required by a State or jurisdiction under its implied consent laws or regulations as defined in §383.72 of this part
- Driving a CMV when, as a result of prior violations committed operating a CMV, the driver's CLP or CDL is revoked, suspended, or canceled, or the driver is disqualified from operating a CMV
- Violations of state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation) arising in connection with any traffic accident and have no record of an accident in which I was at fault
- Causing a fatality through the negligent operation of a CMV, including but not limited to the crimes of motor vehicle manslaughter, homicide by motor vehicle and negligent homicide
- Having an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or greater while operating a CMV
- Leaving the scene of an accident

I have not had more than one (1) conviction for any serious violation listed in 49 CFR 383.51 (c):

- Following a vehicle ahead too closely
- Reckless driving
- Improper or erratic lane changes
- Excessive speeding (15 mph or more above the posted speed limit)
- Violating a State or local law or ordinance on motor vehicle traffic control prohibiting texting while driving a CMV
- Driving a CMV without a CDL in my possession *(An individual shall not be guilty of this offense if he/she provides proof that he/she held a valid CDL on the date the citation was issued; proof must be provided to the law enforcement authority who issued the citation before the individual's court appearance date or before the deadline to pay any fine for the cited violation.)*
- A conviction for a violation of any military, state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than a parking violation, arising in connection with any traffic crash, and has no record of a crash in which he or she was at fault
- Any violation for Railroad Highway Grade Crossing
- Driving a CMV without obtaining a CDL
- Violation arising in connection with a fatal accident
- Driving a CMV without the proper class of CDL and/or endorsements for the specific vehicle group being operated or for the passengers or type of cargo being transported
- Violating a State or local law or ordinance on motor vehicle traffic control restricting or prohibiting the use of a hand-held mobile telephone while driving a CMV

***In compliance with NRS 483.330, I also certify that:***

- I have not had my license or privilege to drive a motor vehicle suspended, revoked, or cancelled during the immediately preceding 4 years
- I have not been convicted of a violation of NRS 484C.130 (vehicular homicide)
- I have not been convicted of a violation of driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs during the immediately preceding 7 years
- I have not had three (3) or more convictions of moving traffic violations during the immediately preceding 4 years
- I have not been convicted of any of the offenses related to the use or operation of a motor vehicle which must be reported to the National Driver Register Problem Driver Pointer System during the immediately preceding 4 years (pursuant to 23 CFR 1327 et seq.)

- I am or was within the past one year regularly employed in a military position requiring operation of a CMV; and
- For at least two years immediately preceding discharge from the military, I operated a vehicle of the same class and type as the one I want to be licensed to drive.

Class B Vehicle: Any single vehicle with a GVWR of 26,001 or more pounds, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle not in excess of 10,000 pounds GVWR.

Class C Vehicle: Any single vehicle or combination of vehicles that does not meet the definition of Class A or Class B, but is either designed to transport 16 or more people including the driver or is placarded for hazardous materials.
