Attention all IFTA & Nevada Special Fuel Users:

LICENSE RENEWAL: In order for your 2009 IFTA/Special FUEL USER renewal to be processed, the renewal application must include the following information:

1. Total number of IFTA decal sets (2 decal stickers for each qualified motor vehicle power unit). 1 set equals 2 decals
2. If you file your IFTA fuel tax return in another jurisdiction, or under another Nevada carrier name you must provide an updated consolidation letter for IFTA qualified apportioned vehicles.
3. If your IFTA mileage and fuel use are reported under another company, you must provide an updated lease agreement that specifies the party responsible for reporting and payment of fuel taxes in the case of lessors/lessees, independent contractors, and household goods agents. If a company is filing its IFTA fuel tax returns out of state, you must also include a letter from that state confirming the company is filing its fuel.
4. Include a current notarized power of attorney authorizing the preparer to sign the tax report if your tax returns are filed by a tax preparer, such as an accounting firm, tax and licensing agent or any other entity.

“IFTA qualified motor vehicle” means a motor vehicle used, designed, or maintained for transportation of persons or property having a gross vehicle weight exceeding 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms, or having three (3) or more axles regardless of weight, or is used in combination, when the weight of such combination exceeds 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms gross vehicle weight. It does not include recreational vehicles. The vehicle must travel in Nevada and at least one other IFTA jurisdiction.

Special Fuel User” means any person who consumes in this state special fuel (i.e. diesel, propane, natural gas) for the propulsion of motor vehicles owned or controlled by him upon the highways of this state, including highways under construction.

Special Note: A Special Fuel User license is still required of all Special Fuel Users with vehicles weighing 26,001 pounds or more even though you do not need to file Special Fuel User tax returns.
