

VEHICLE TRANSPORTER INFORMATION

“Vehicle transporter” defined. “Vehicle transporter” means a person who engages in the business of transporting motor vehicles in which he has no ownership interest and which are otherwise required to be registered pursuant to this chapter by operating them, singly or in combination, upon the highway under their own motive power. NRS 482.137

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

1. Application for Business License (OBL237) completed in full and signed by a principal of the business.
2. Personal History Questionnaire (OBL242) completed by each principal of the business listed on the license application.
3. Applicant photograph, which must be in color, at least 2” x 2” (passport photo size) and show full face, shoulders and above.
4. One set of fingerprints, for each principal of the business. Applicants must be fingerprinted by an authorized DMV representative or law enforcement agency. Some agencies may charge for fingerprinting, check with your local agency.
5. DPS Civil Applicant Waiver (OBL256) completed and signed by each applicant.
6. A surety bond (OBL210) or deposit in lieu of bond in the amount of \$100,000.
7. Insurance certificate showing automobile liability coverage. See insurance information sheet (OBL273).
8. Non-refundable license application fee of \$101, which includes a Technology Fee.
9. Fingerprint processing fees of \$36.25 for each principal listed on application.
10. City or County business license.
11. Fictitious Firm Name Filing.
12. Copy of Certificate of Incorporation and Corporate filing, with names of the officers, filed with the Nevada Secretary of State’s office, if applicable.
13. The federal identification number (FEIN) of the business.
14. An electronic mail (e-mail) address for the business.
15. Two color photographs that clearly show the exterior of the business to include the display sign.
