

GARAGE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

“Garage” means a business establishment, sole proprietorship, firm, corporation, association or other legal entity that performs any of the following services on motor vehicles:

- Repair or replacement of the:
 - ✓ Engine;
 - ✓ Brake system;
 - ✓ Transmission system;
 - ✓ Drive train system;
 - ✓ Heating and air conditioning system;
 - ✓ Cooling system;
 - ✓ Muffler and exhaust system;
 - ✓ Electrical system;
 - ✓ Electrical charging system; or
 - ✓ Fuel injection or carburetion system;
- Engine tune up;
- Diagnostic testing;
- Alignment; or
- Oil change and lubrication.

“Garage” does not include a business establishment, sole proprietorship, firm, corporation, association or other legal entity that does not perform services on motor vehicles for members of the general public. NRS 487.540

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Application for Business License (OBL237) completed in full and signed by a principal of the business.
2. A surety bond (OBL269) or deposit in lieu of bond in the amount of \$5,000.
3. Non-refundable registration application fee of \$26.00, which includes a Technology fee. Vehicle dealers, manufacturers, distributors, rebuilders, automobile wreckers, salvage pools, body shops, authorized inspection stations, and authorized stations are exempt from the issuance or renewal fee of a registration. NRS 487.560
4. City or County business license.
5. Fictitious Firm Name Filing.
6. Copy of Certificate of Incorporation and Corporate filing, with names of the officers, filed with the State of Nevada, Secretary of State’s Office, if applicable.
7. The Federal Identification Number (FEIN) of the business.
8. An electronic mail address for the business.
9. An established place of business within the state.
10. A sign 22 inches by 28 inches stating the customer’s bill of rights as noted in NRS 487.6871. The sign must be easily visible in an area within the business, frequented by persons seeking repairs for motor vehicles.

NOTE: Garages are not subject to registration if they provide repairs only on motor trucks with a gross weight exceeding 10,000 pounds. NRS 487.550.

Late Fee: A license that expires for failure to renew may be reinstated upon submission to the Department of: a completed application for renewal, a renewal fee, and a late fee of \$25.00.
