2. Approval of Agenda Order

- A. Dennis Ransel with Clark County requested to have agenda item #5, ***Discuss purpose and appoint members to participate in the approved IM program review subcommittee*** removed. There were no objections from the Committee.
- B. The agenda was approved in the order it was prepared with the exception of the item 5's removal.

3. Continuous Monitoring including Heavy Duty Diesel/Gas and Light Duty Diesel Vehicles

- A. Continuous monitoring is the use of technology, such as a device to detect compliance with emission standards.
- B. The majority of the fleets in Nevada currently have a GPS tracking product installed in their vehicles to enhance operations. The device that is used interfaces with the vehicles engine computer to provide remote vehicle diagnostics information in real time. This tracking process sends what is called an automatic alert through the use of satellites to the

fleet manager. This is done when the engine computer senses a problem with the vehicle emission components.

C. Glenn Smith with the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) informed the members of the Committee that the Department has started moving forward with the Continuous Monitoring Project. The Department has drafted regulations for review and holding joint meetings with Department of Motor Vehicles IT section (MVIT) professionals to start designing the program.

D. In 2014, heavy duty diesel vehicles will be OBD equipped. The Department will look into bringing those fleets into the program after gasoline fleets has been implemented.

➤ **Q.** Washoe County – Is this program environmentally driven or service driven? What is driving this program?

➤ **A.** Debbie Shope – This is service driven, but the program will prove to have environmental benefits also.

➤ **A.** Steve Yarborough w/Fleet Solutions – Currently, fleets do not have to repair vehicles until the emission inspection is due so that they are able to pass the emission inspection. As a result, you have dirty vehicles emitting for a full year until registration and emission inspection is due. The fleets that have these devices are now servicing the vehicles throughout the year when the managers receive a vehicle diagnostic alert.

4. Pollution Control Account Update

A. As of December 15, 2011 the pollution control account is totaling in at 4 million, which in comparison to last fiscal year's revenue growth we are in the negative. The account is displaying a **-2.11%** in comparison to the same time last year.

➤ **Q.** Robert Tekniepe – Debbie do you know what the anticipated reserve projection is?

➤ **A.** Debbie Shope – No. I will not receive that information until the first part of February.
