4. Public Comments:

- A. Steven Weiss {Smog Hut}, brought up concerns about new vehicles being out of Federal Emissions warranty if exempted by the sub-committees recommendation.

5. Approval of Agenda Order

- A. The Agenda was approved in the order it was prepared.

6. Approval of March Meeting Minutes

- A. The Madam Chairwoman opened the March 22nd, 2016 meeting minutes for discussion and approval. The sub-committee approved the minutes as presented.

7. Review, discussion and adoption of the final draft of the AB146 report.

- A. The Sub-Committee discussed changes made to the Executive Summary including the following changes that will be included in the master draft:
 - Removal of cost effectiveness arguments.
 - The removal of the US Census Bureau definition of western states as it does not include Texas.
 - Second page, second argument removed and items re-numbered.
 - Test frequency language changed to be more specific.
 - Addition of a section on the revenue impact to the Industry.
- B. Glenn Smith {DMV/CED}, provided copies of his recommended changes regarding classic vehicles emission test requirements. (*Attachment A retained in Departments master file*)

- C. The Sub-Committee reviewed the entire report from “Table of Contents” to “Appendices”. All changes were notated, with a request to have hardcopies of the changes emailed to Joseph Perreira w/NDEP for updating. Joe requested that all content edits be emailed today, so corrections could be made before the full I/M Committee meeting.

8. Identification and discussion of any other considerations to be included in the report, such as waiver provisions.

- A. Charlene {WC –AQMD}, requested the presentation of the AB146 report to the full I/M Committee be a group effort. Each presenter was requested to only highlight the high points in each section. Assigned presenters and sections are as follows:
- Al Leskys {CC-DAQEM}, will present sections 5, 6, 7 & 9.
 - Joe Perreira {NDEP}, will present section 8.
 - Charlene Albee {WC–AQMD}, will present the Executive Summary.
 - Glenn Smith {DMV/CED}, will present sections 3 & 4.
 - Sig Jaunarajs {NDEP}, will present section 2.
- B. Section 10 of the report will be merged with Appendix D due to duplication. Charlene Albee {WC–AQMD}, will be responsible for this change.
- C. The sub-committee agreed that an additional full I/M Committee meeting may need to be called in May if significant content changes result from the full I/M Committee review. If no further content changes are required, the AB146 report will be ready for approval of the I/M Committee and submitted by the chairman to LCB.
- D. Charlene Albee {WC–AQMD}, stated that the report will be included with the full I/M committee agenda as a .pdf attachment.

9. Informational Item(s)

- A. Morgan Friend {DMV/CED}, during the last sub-committee meeting, it was requested that the DMV perform a comparison between our State and other jurisdictions. In comparing surrounding jurisdictions, the Department was not able to find a comparable jurisdiction.

10. Public Comments:

- A. Steven Weiss {Smog Hut}, requested an update on the timeframe of implementation. Joe Perreira {NDEP}, informed Steven that this was only a report. There would not be any implementation unless the Legislature takes action based on our recommendations in 2017.
- B. Bill Dell {OPUS Inspection}, suggested with regards to potential enhancements for future technology, the State should consider the addition of SAE J2534. This device allows the

vehicle system to deliver more information than OBD II and additional diagnostic information.

11. Next Meeting and Adjournment

- A. No future I/M Sub-Committee meetings will be scheduled. The current determination of the members is the sub-committee has completed its directive. Pending the outcome of the draft review; a meeting might be necessary, but is not anticipated.
