5. Approval of Agenda Order

A. The Agenda was approved by the committee in the order it was presented.

6. Approval of June 2018 Meeting Minutes:

A. June meeting minutes were approved with 2 corrections.

7. Approval of July 2018 Meeting Minutes:

A. July meeting minutes were approved.

8. Status Update on Nevada’s Allotment of Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust Funds:

A. Sig Jaunarajs (NDEP); Filling in for Joseph Pereira, the committee has been formed to review applications and make final selections. Announcements are to be made on the winners by the end of the month.

Q: Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); For the first round, how much funds are available?

A: Sig Jaunarajs (NDEP); It would be no more than a third.

Q: William Striejewske (NDOA); will there be a number of winners or just however many it takes to deplete the available funding?

A: Sig Jaunarajs (NDEP); Not all winners will be completely funded. There will probably be a priority list of winners.

B. Sig Jaunarajs (NDEP); some of the funds are already earmarked for the electric charging stations. We are working with the office of energy, the first project being in Moapa.

Q: Mark Costa (NDOT); What's the total amount expected to be awarded in this round?

A: Sig Jaunarajs (NDEP); We are not sure, a third or less than a third of twenty-five million. Probably less. The second round will be next year.

9. Legislative Update:

A. Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); There is nothing at the moment that needs to be addressed.

10. Membership Expirations:

A. Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); There are some membership expirations coming up. If you haven't received your letter, you should be receiving it soon.

Q: Mike Sword (CC/DAQEM); We are sending it back. Can it be an electronic copy or do you need a hard copy?

A: Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); A hard copy is preferred.

Q: Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); Is there an effective date for these terms or is it as they are approved by the Deputy Director?

A: Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); I believe it is from the date from which it is approved by the Deputy Director. I believe the terms are two years from that date.

11. Nomination of New Committee Chairman: CLARK COUNTY; (for possible action)

A. Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); Identified that it was time to nominate a new Chairman.

B. Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); Called for nominations. Motion was made to recommend Mike Sword as Chairman of the IM Committee. Recommendation was seconded. Motion was carried and Mike Sword was nominated as Chairman of the IM Committee.

12. Nomination of New Committee Vice Chairman: (for possible action)

- A. Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); Identified that it was time to nominate a new Vice Chairman.
- B. Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); Called for nominations. Motion was made to recommend William Striejewske as Vice Chairman of the IM Committee. Recommendation was seconded. Motion was carried and William Striejewske was nominated as the Vice Chairman of the IM Committee.

13. 2019 Committee Meeting Schedule: (for possible action)

- A. The 2019 meeting schedule was approved. The IM Committee will meet on January 8, 2019, April 9, 2019, July 9, 2019 and October 8, 2019 at 2:00 pm.

14. Informational Items:

- A. Charlene Albee (WC-AQMD); Health District developed a legislative liaison position that will be working for the Health District with other inter-governmental agencies with a focus on the legislature. Once the position is approved there will be someone in Carson City that will be able to put Air Quality and IM to the forefront and we think that is going to be a real benefit. The employee should be on board by the end of the month.
- B. Mark Costa (NDOT); Introduced their draft of the long term transportation plan that is out for public comment on the website at "1NVplan.com". They will be taking comments until Oct. 29th.

15. Public Comments:

- A. Morgan Friend (DMV/CED); Introduced J.D. Decker as the new Administrator of the Compliance Enforcement Division.
- B. J.D. Decker (DMV/CED); Heavy Duty Diesel Program is back up and running. This is the only program that regulates diesel trucks over 14,000 lbs. The Program consists of two uniformed officers in marked units in the south and one in the north.

Q: Daniel Inouye (WC-AQMD); Is the patrolling concentrated on the highways or truck routes?

A: J.D. Decker (DMV/CED); Highways, Truck Routes, Gravel pits, wherever its most likely they will observe the most amount of trucks.
