4. Public Comments.

- A. Peter Krueger, with Nevada Emission Testers Council, thanked DMV publicly for reconsidering the issues with the VID the previous month.

5. Approval of Agenda Order.

- A. The Agenda was approved in the order it was prepared.

6. Approval of October Meeting Minutes.

- A. The Chairman opened up the October 13th, 2015 meeting minutes for discussion and approval. The Sub-Committee approved the minutes as presented.

7. Hear and Discuss Suggestion to Update and Modernize the I/M Program made by the Emission testing Industry.

- A. Peter Krueger, with Nevada Emission Testers Council, stated many things could be accomplished with the input of the industry. He suggested that small changes/work be allowed to be done by the industry; examples: printer changes and filter changes.
- B. Lou Gardella, with Jiffy Smog/Nevada Emission Testers Council, presented a list of the top 10 items that the industry would like to see happen;
 1. Delete NAC 445b.559, NRS 445.210, 770, 785, 830.
 2. A New DMV online VID status page and blog.
 3. Inspector licensing going from “per station” to valid at all NV stations.
 4. Inspector lock outs allowed to be reset via a phone call.
 5. Mandate any VID updates to be done at night and tested beforehand.

6. Re-establish offline testing of up to 30 tests.
 7. Re-establish auto VIR ordering when the count goes below 25.
 8. Enforce that all stations that are licensed to do renewals be required to take all forms of payment.
 9. Allow renewal documents to be submitted electronically to the DMV.
 10. Establish an annual meeting between the industry and the DMV to discuss problems both parties see and possible solutions.
- C. Will Adler, with Nevada Emission Testers Council, stated that we will continue to see a trend where air quality measures in Nevada. It will become harder and more stringent to attain. He feels it would be odd to go from annual to bi-annual testing. He also stated that we have a system that complies with air quality. It is quick, efficient and cheap.
- D. Sig Jaunarajs, with Nevada Department of Environmental Protection, stated that the suggestions made by Lou should be considered very carefully. He also acknowledged that DMV has a lot of computer challenges and believes that some, if not most, of the concerns addressed can be resolved.
- E. Charlene Albee, with Washoe County Air Quality Management Division, concurs with Sig Jaunarajs. Many of the items are administrative and DMV is tasked with these duties. She also stated that the pricing concern will be added to the fiscal portion of this report.
- Ivie Hatt, with Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles, was tasked with posting a notice on the VID Electronic Messenger to have suggestions from the industry sent to Lou Gardella, with Jiffy Smog/Nevada Emission Testers Council. These will then be sorted out, condensed and forwarded to Mary Carbajal, with Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles, for further distribution.

8. Proposed changes to the Testing Standards.

- A. The Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles has no specific changes to recommend on the standard testing procedures.

9. Discussion on Classic Vehicles.

- The Sub-Committee came up with the following recommends/suggestions to be added to the Classic Vehicle Program:
- Incorporating language to better define what a “Classic Vehicle” is.
 - Require classic vehicle insurance.
 - Odometer mileage verification done at an emission station.
